What is a Crisis Pregnancy Center?

SERVICES

- Pregnancy testing/verification
- Parenting classes
- Material assistance
- Abstinence-only education

TECHNIQUES

- "Ministry-minded"
- Discourage abortion, often through misinformation
- Do not provide referrals to medical providers
- Rely on confusion



HISTORY OF CPCs

- Robert Pearson often referred to as the founder of the first crisis pregnancy center (CPC) in 1960s Honolulu
- Alternatives to Abortion formed in 1971 as a loose affiliation of CPCs – later renamed Heartbeat International
- Care Net opens first CPC in 1983
- National Institute of Family and Life Advocates (NIFLA) forms in 1994 to provide legal counsel to CPCs
- 1991 Congressional Investigation found nearly 2,000 CPCs in the US
- ~2,000 CPCs associated with Care Net, Heartbeat International, and NIFLA





Detrimental to Patient Health

- The vast majority of the federally funded CPCs contacted during the investigation provided false or misleading medical information.
- Deceive clients and pose a barrier to accessing medical care.
