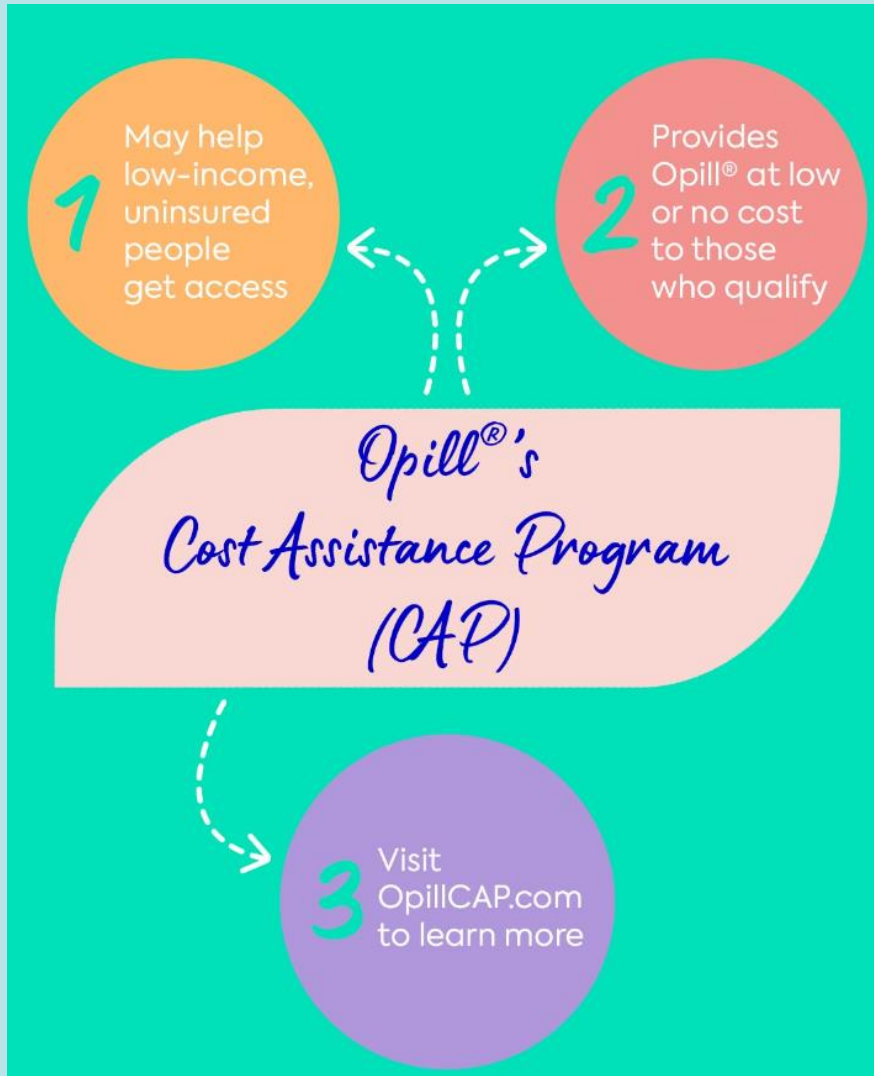
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What is NFPRHA hearing about Opill rollout?

- State Medicaid programs are waiting for more information from the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS)
- Some State Medicaid programs are utilizing standing orders
- There is conflation between over-the-counter access to Opill and access through a prescribing pharmacist
- CVS Caremark Pharmacy Benefit Manager (PBM) is covering Opill without a prescription
- Other items?



What is NFPRHA concerned about?



- The manufacturer suggested price is too high for patients *and* providers
- Use of standing orders impedes access for Medicaid enrollees and creates a two-tier system for accessing Opill
- Under current interpretation of federal law, states cannot cover over-the-counter products in Medicaid without a prescription unless they forgo the federal match for those products
- Other items?
