*The Arizona Family Health Partnership receives a second grant to provide services in the Navajo Nation. Gila River Health Care receives a Title X grant to provide services to the Gila River Indian Community.

Title X-funded health centers helped women avoid one million unintended pregnancies in 2013, which prevented 501,000 unplanned births and 345,000 abortions.

Despite these positive health impacts, federal funding for Title X has shrunk, and now fewer low-income and uninsured people across the country, and in Arizona, are able to access family planning and sexual health services funded by Title X.

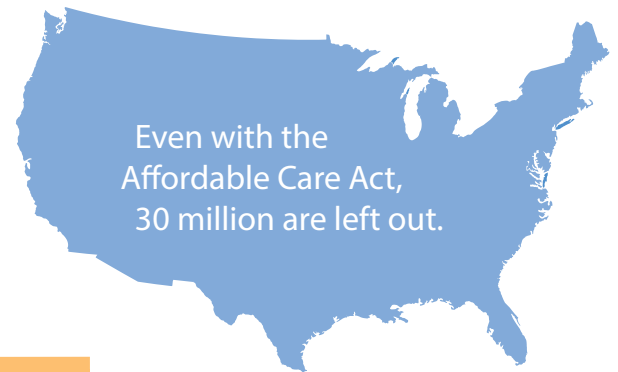

The grantee has not had funding available for HIV services since 2014. A percentage of funds has been dedicated to meeting new Title X guidelines and for electronic health record support.

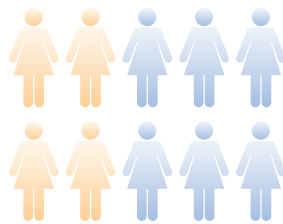
