

State Charitable Registration Disclosures

Some states require charitable solicitation disclosure statements to be included on all written materials mailed to potential contributors in their states. The following is a list of disclosure statements that must be printed on all charitable solicitations mailed in to the residents of these states. This information is not intended as legal counsel and does not constitute legal advice.

The National Family Planning & Reproductive Health Association (NFPRHA) is a charitable organization exempt from taxation under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code, and as such, we are required to include certain disclosure language on all printed solicitations.
