The Title X family planning program, administered by the Office of Population Affairs, is the nation's only grant program dedicated solely to providing family planning and other preventive health care to low-income, under-insured, and uninsured individuals who otherwise lack access to care. In 2015, OPA provided Title X funding to 91 grantees that support a network of 3,951 service sites in communities across the country. Family planning and sexual health care includes:

- Contraception
- Counseling
- Services for STDs
- HIV testina
- Cervical cancer screening




Title X funds are not the sole source of income for the family planning safety net.
