
THE TITLE X FAMILY PLANNING PROGRAM IN

The North Carolina Department of Health and Human Services and Planned Parenthood South Atlantic are the Title X grantees in North Carolina. The diverse network of health centers supported by Title X provides a range of essential preventive health services, including breast and cervical cancer detection, screening and treatment for sexually transmitted diseases, HIV testing, and contraception, for thousands of low-income, uninsured, and underinsured individuals and families each year who would otherwise lack access to care.

Despite this important mission, federal funding for Title X has shrunk in recent years, and now fewer low-income and uninsured people in North Carolina are able to access family planning and sexual health services funded by Title X.




