
THE TITLE X FAMILY PLANNING PROGRAM IN

The New Mexico Department of Health is the Title X grantee in New Mexico. The diverse network of health centers supported by Title X provides a range of essential preventive health services, including breast and cervical cancer detection, screening and treatment for sexually transmitted diseases, HIV testing, and contraception, for thousands of lowincome, uninsured, and underinsured individuals and families each year who would otherwise lack access to care.

Despite this important mission, federal funding for Title X has shrunk in recent years, and now fewer low-income and uninsured people in New Mexico are able to access family planning and sexual health services funded by Title X.
