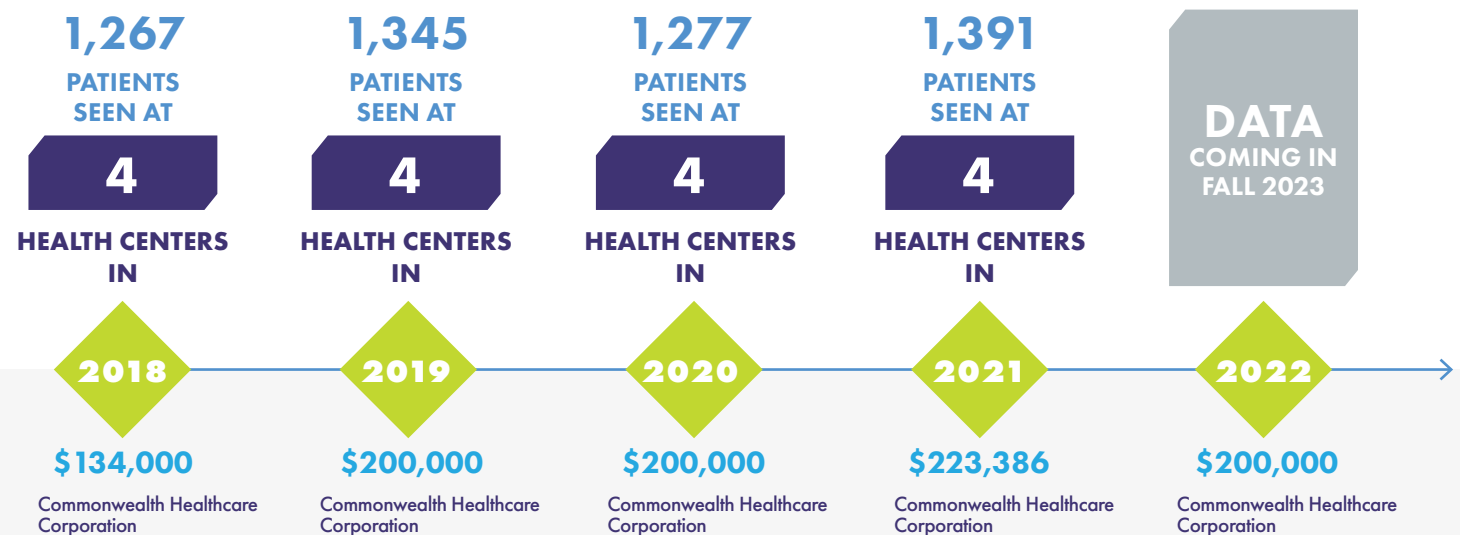

The Office of Population Affairs collected only binary sex data

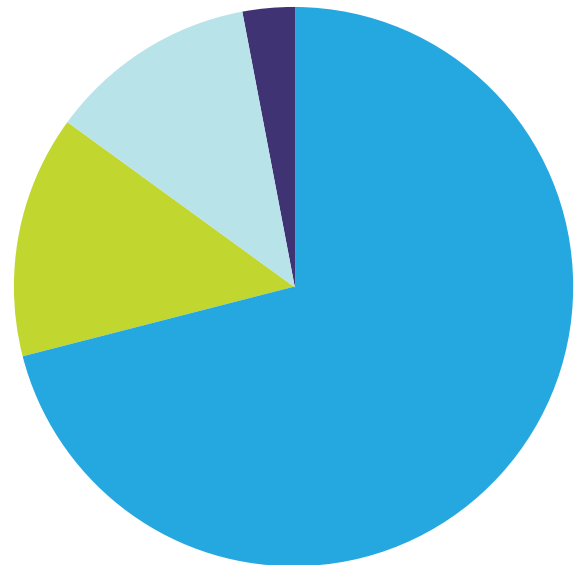

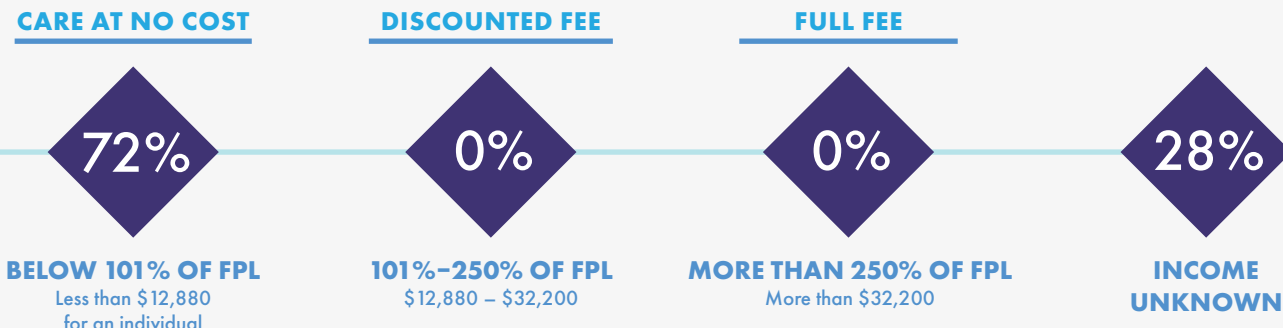
