TITLE X PATIENTS BY SEX

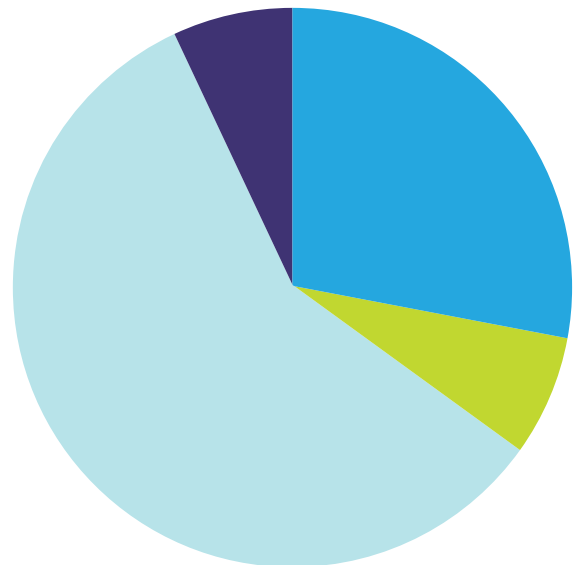

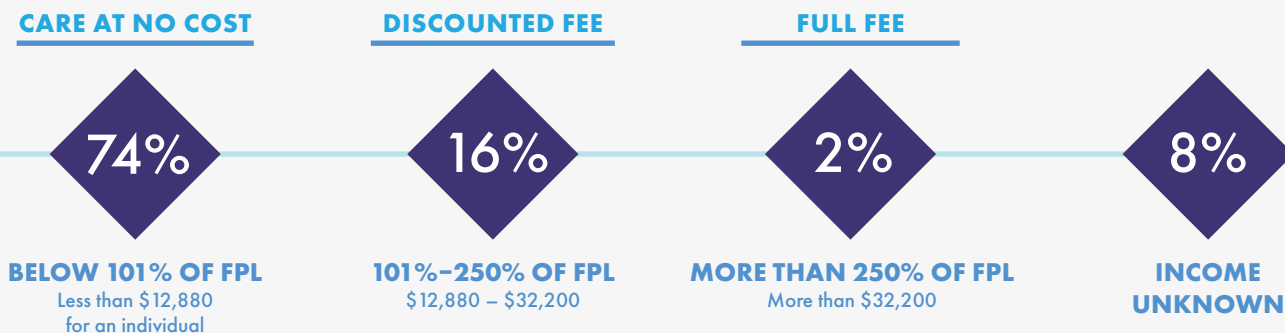
