Data Notes

- Unless noted otherwise, data reflect information that was publicly available as of March 2023.
- National data typically only reflects people living in the 50 states and the District of Columbia.
- The Title X network experienced a seismic shift in 2019 when the Trump administration's 2019 program rule went into effect. More than 1,000 service sites left the program at that time. Most grantees were not able to rebuild their networks or rejoin the program until 2022. The population served in 2021, as reflected on the back of each sheet, may not be representative of the population typically served in the program.
